

Environment Series: Port of Vancouver Discovery Centre

Vancouver is Canada's largest and busiest port. The Port of Vancouver plays a critical role in managing the port, and keeping our waterways safe and clean. Come for a visit to their newly renovated Discovery Centre to learn about the port authority through an interactive and informative presentation. A port delegate will discuss their role as a port authority, their five business sectors, infrastructure and development plans, and their environmental initiatives, and answer questions.

Wayfinding & Visit:

Participants will meet at the Discovery Centre for a prompt 10 am start.

Arriving by SeaBus or SkyTrain:

- Exit at Waterfront Station
- Walk west on Cordova Street
- Turn north on Howe Street
- Enter Canada Place



Parking at Canada Place:

- Entry to the Canada Place parkade is at the very north end of Howe Street in downtown Vancouver
- Tickets are obtained from the ticket dispenser or the ticket booth
- There are two parking levels. Park at the far north end of the parking lot
- Take the elevators to level G (ground level)

When you arrive at Canada Place:

- The Discovery Centre does not have washrooms; public washrooms are near the south entrance to Canada Place, in the foyer of the Vancouver Convention Centre East or by the cafe on your way down the concourse
- Meet just inside the sliding glass doors of the Discovery Centre at the north end of the concourse in Canada Place (walk inside to the far end of the long hallway on the west side of the building)
- Should you require assistance, look for the giant maple leaf indicating the Welcome Centre where staff can direct you and provide assistance.
